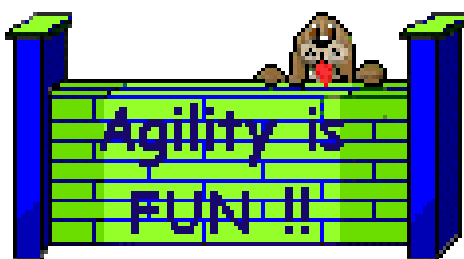

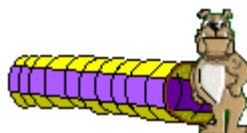
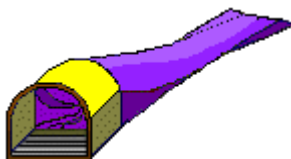

JUMPING CLASS RULES

Class 1 Steeplechase

K.C jumping heights; allsorts can run at small or medium height.

Flowing jumping course NO WEAVES

Usual scoring will apply.

Class 2 Silence Is Golden

K.C jumping heights; allsorts can run at small or medium height

A jumping course, that the handler must direct the dog round without speaking to the dog, usual scoring plus 5 faults every time you speak to your dog.

Class 3 Football Fiasco

Full jumping course set at small height

3 Footballs will be strategically placed by 3 jumps

Handler has 3 options

Kick the ball over the jump.....10 points

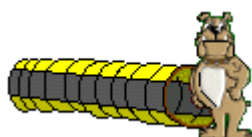
Throw the ball over the jump.....5 points

Ignore the ball.....5 faults

Handler may down their dog before attempting to kick/throw ball, then must direct dog over the jump. Usual scoring on the jumping, Faults & points will be converted into seconds. Faults incurred in jumping will be added to time, points will be deducted from time.

Class 4 Tunnel Teaser

The course consists of rigid & cloth tunnels, There will be lots of traps, 5 faults every time the dog takes the wrong tunnel!!

AGILITY CLASS RULES

Class 5 POWER & SPEED

K.C jumping heights; Allsorts can run at small or medium height
Usual scoring on both parts. 1st part of the course (POWER) will consist of contacts weaves and long jump, this part will not be timed. 2nd part (SPEED) will consist of jumps and tunnels this part will be timed.

Class 6 Contact Donut

Dog and handler start in the middle of the ring, dog on the low table, either in a down or sit, time starts as soon as dogs front paws touch ground, you then proceed around the course in a circle consisting of contacts and tunnels, then back on table, time stops as soon as dog is in down on table. Usual scoring on equipment.

Class 7 TOUCH & GO

The course consists of contacts and tunnels only. Refusals are not faulted. All the handler has to worry about is the dog touching the contacts and staying on the course. It will be scored on faults, so the dog with the fewest faults will win. Time is therefore the tie breaker. Failure to complete the course 20 faults

Running the wrong course 10 faults

Missed contact 5 faults

Body blocking 10 Faults (placement of the handlers body between the dog and the obstacle to prevent dog from taking it)

Class 8 Egg 'N Spoon Pairs

Dogs and handlers will run a simple agility course, jumps will be small height; handler will carry an egg and spoon around course, and pass it to second handler, you and your dogs, must be in the box during change over. Usual scoring, plus 5 faults every time handler drops the egg.

Class 1. **Puppy's** (up to 10 months.)
Heel on lead. Recall on line. 30 second sit. 30 second down

Class 2. **Beginners** (not to have won any obedience 1st-3rd)
Heel on lead. Recall on line. 1minute sit. 1 minute down.

Class 3. **Let's Have A Go.** (Open to all)
Heel on lead. Recall off lead. 1minute sit. 1minute down.
Handling(show you can touch and inspect your dog)

Class 4. **Now Harder** (open to all)
Heel free with position. Recall. Retrieve article. 2minute sit stay. 2minute down stay

Refreshments will be available Saturday & Sunday.

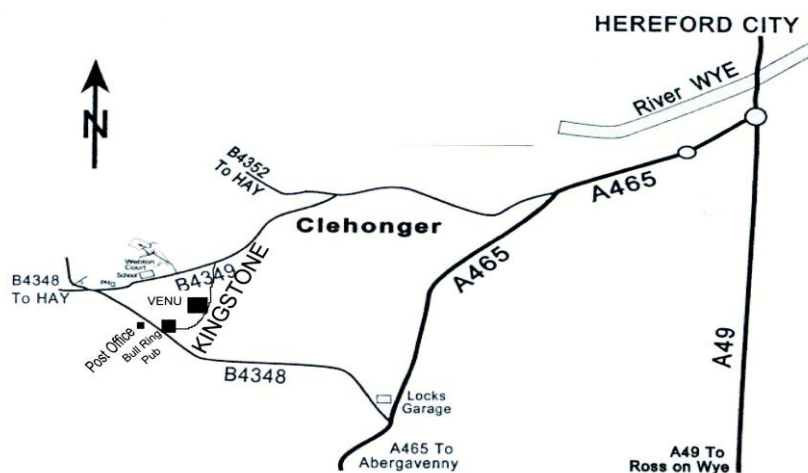
(Locks Garage is 2.5 miles away, caters for groceries newspapers etc, post office/stores and pub in the village all shown on map.)

Leave Hereford on the A465 (Abergavenny Rd) .Just passed Belmont Abbey turn right to Hay on Wye on the (B4348). After about 2 miles take left fork on the B4349 to Kingstone. Continue for about 1.5 miles turn left to Kingstone, Venue approx ¼ mile on right.

From South West turn left on to the B4348, at Locks garage on to the B4348 (to Hay on Wye) continue approx 2.5 miles, then turn right at Bull Ring pub, venue approx ½ mile on left.
